

## Jesus Timeline: Activity Stream in the Final Year

Nisan 10.

~1476 BCE Exodus Event: The head of each household would select an unblemished young male lamb to be offered as a sacrifice to the LORD.

Yearly Festival Activity: Same.

Nisan 10.

0033-03-29 Sunday.

Triumphal Entry.

Jesus enters the city, riding on a donkey to announce His Messiahship.

Nisan 15 (Full moon, 15th day of the first month (Spring) of the lunar calendar).

Passover.

~1476 BCE Exodus Event: On the evening of Nisan 15 (EREV PESAKH), a family member was to slaughter the lamb (called KORBAN PESAKH) and smear some of its blood on all three sides of the doorframe, top, right and left. The lamb was then to be roasted and eaten with unleavened bread (i.e., MATZAH) and MAROR (bitter herbs).

Yearly Festival Activity: Sacrificing the Passover lamb in the afternoon of Nisan 14.

Nisan 15.

0033-04-02 Thursday evening.

The Last Supper of Jesus.

In the Garden of Gethsemane.

Jesus is betrayed and arrested.

The religious leaders condemn Jesus.

People give false testimonies against Jesus.

Nisan 15 00:01.

~1476 BCE Exodus Event: At midnight on Nisan 15 the Lord killed all the firstborn males of those who did not put the blood of the lamb upon their doorposts. Those who trusted in the Lord were "passed over" (PASAKH) by the angel of death.

Nisan 15 morning.

~1476 BCE Exodus Event: The people left in haste out of captivity / slavery / bondage.

Nisan 15.

0033-04-03 Friday.

Preparation Day (that is, the day before Shabbat) (Mk. 15:42, Lk. 23:54)

0033-04-03 Friday 06:00.

Jesus stands trial before Pilate.

Jesus sent to Herod.

0033-04-03 Friday 07:00

Jesus returned to Pilate.

Jesus is sentenced to death.

0033-04-03 Friday 08:00

Jesus is led away to Calvary.

The Crucifixion:

0033-04-03 Friday 09:00 - "The Third Hour"

Jesus is crucified on the cross.

The soldiers cast lots for Jesus' clothing.

0033-04-03 Friday 10:00.

Jesus is insulted and mocked.

0033-04-03 Friday 11:00.

Jesus and the criminal.

Jesus speaks to Mary and John.

0033-04-03 Friday 12:00 - "The Sixth Hour"

Darkness covers the land.

0033-04-03 Friday 15:00 - "The Ninth Hour"

Jesus cries out to the Father, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

It is finished.

The earthquake.

Matthew 27:51-52 - At that moment the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook and the rocks split. The tombs broke open and the bodies of many holy people who had died were raised to life. (NIV)

The centurion - "Surely he was the Son of God!"

0033-04-03 Friday 16:00

The soldiers break the thieves' legs.

The soldier pierces Jesus's side.

0033-04-03 Friday, before evening.

Jesus is laid in the tomb.

0033-04-04 Saturday.

Resting day (Shabbat).

Nisan 17.

0033-04-05 Sunday <05:00.

Jesus resurrects / rises from the dead.

Nisan 17.

Festival of the First Fruits (חג הביכורים) (KHAG HA'BIKURIM).

Day 1 of 50.

Yearly Festival Activity (starting after 40 years of wandering in the desert):

Waving a sheaf of the barley harvest as an offering to God, each day for 49 days.

Feast of Unleavened Bread (from Nisan 15 to Nisan 22) (חג המצות) (KHAG HA'MATZOT).

Jesus visits his disciples over a period of 40 days (from 0033-04-05 Sunday to 0033-05-14 Thursday).

0033-05-14 Thursday.

Day 40 of 50.

Jesus rose / ascended to heaven.

Apostle Matthias chosen.

Shavuot.

Festival of Weeks (חג השבועות) (KHAG HA'SHAVUOT) = Pentecost (Πεντηκοστή).

Day 50 of 50. 7 weeks after the Festival of the First Fruits.

~1476 BCE Exodus Event: Giving of the Law by God (זמן מתן תורתנו) (ZMAN MATAN TORATEINU).

Yearly Festival Activity: Dancing around bonfire and singing. The Passover is the Festival of "Physical Redemption" while the Shavuot is the Festival of "Spiritual Redemption".

0033-05-24 Sunday: People receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit to spread the Gospel in all languages.
